Earth Science (Meets UC/CSU a-g science requirement; physical science)  
Biology (must take/have taken Algebra 1, lab, meets UC/CSU a-g science requirement; life science)  
Chemistry (must take/have taken Algebra 1, meets UC/CSU a-g science requirement, physical science)  
AP Chemistry (teacher approval and contract required, meets UC/CSU a-g science requirement)

\*Students may take agriculture electives alone or combine them to become “Ag Completers.” Ag Completers must pass Ag Science 1, Ag Science 2, Ag Mechanics, and an agriculture elective. Ag Completers receive graduation credit for two years of science. Only Ag Biology meets UC science requirements.
