SCIENCE - (2 years required for graduation; 2 years required for CSU/UC, 3-4 years recommended.)

NOTE: UNR requires three years of science and will count Ag Science or Earth Science for third year.

Ag Science 1* (does NOT meet UC/CSU a-g science requirement, qualifies as a-g elective)
Ag Science 2* (does NOT meet UC/CSU a-g science requirement, qualifies as a-g elective)
Earth Science (Meets UC/CSU a-g science requirement; physical science)
Biology (must take/have taken Algebra 1, lab, meets UC/CSU a-g science requirement, life science)
Ag. Biology (must take/have taken Algebra 1, meets UC/CSU a-g science requirement)
Chemistry (must take/have taken Algebra 1, meets UC/CSU a-g science requirement, physical science)
AP Chemistry (teacher approval and contract required, meets UC/CSU science requirement)

*Students may take agriculture electives alone or combine them to become “Ag Completers.” Ag Completers must pass Ag Science 1, Ag Science 2, Ag Mechanics, and an agriculture elective. Ag Completers receive graduation credit for two years of science. Only Ag Biology meets UC/CSU science requirements.
